

### **Students in Need of Isolation or Quarantine**

Students should make every attempt to return home to isolate or quarantine. SAU does have a limited number of isolation and quarantine spaces for those students needing to remain on campus.

The process for placing students in quarantine or isolation:

University Health Services (UHS) receives notification of or identifies a student in need of isolation or quarantine.

UHS interviews student to determine if the student can return home or if campus housing is necessary.

### **Students Returning Home to Isolate or Quarantine**

- If the student is returning home to isolate, UHS will obtain an items-required list from the student, and utilizing appropriate PPE, will procure the items requested from the student's campus residence on behalf of the student.
- If the student is returning home to quarantine, the student will be allowed to return to the campus residence, escorted by University housing staff (suitemates/roommates cleared from room), and wearing appropriate PPE, for a period of no more than 15 minutes will be allowed to retrieve personal items prior to returning home to quarantine.
- Students should monitor health daily and report new or worsening symptoms to their PCP or if necessary, visit the nearest emergency department and notify the staff of their COVID-19 status.
- The Dean of Students will be notified of the student's home isolation/quarantine status and will alert professors of approved class absence status. Students are aware that academic resources are provided during isolation/quarantine, and unless prevented due to illness, students should continue to participate in academic programs.
- Students will be provided contact information for UHS and a designated academic advisor prior to returning home to isolate/quarantine.
- Students will be contacted every five days by UHS and any academic issues not reported by the student will be reported to the academic advisor assigned to the student's case.
- Prior to returning to campus, students should contact UHS and obtain a letter of clearance from the health department of their home state.

## **Students Remaining on Campus to Isolate or Quarantine**

- UHS will contact student housing to initiate alternate campus housing on behalf of the student.
- Housing will generate a room assignment.
- Housing will assign one staff member as a primary contact for the student.
- Housing will notify UHS of the room assignment and primary housing contact information.
- UHS will contact the student and provide housing details and primary housing contact information.
- If the student is remaining on campus to isolate, UHS will obtain an items-required list from the student, and utilizing appropriate PPE, will procure the items requested from the student's campus residence on behalf of the student.
- If the student is remaining on campus to quarantine, the student will be allowed to return to the campus residence, escorted by University housing staff (suitemates/roommates cleared from room), and wearing appropriate PPE, for a period of no more than 15 minutes will be allowed to retrieve personal items prior to returning home to quarantine.
- Prior to student arrival at alternate campus location, University housing staff will deliver to the isolation/quarantine location:
  - The key for entry (location disclosed to student by primary contact).
  - Information kit containing numerous contact numbers that may be needed by the student, additional information about COVID-19 and self-care, disposable thermometers and masks, and a quarantine/isolation agreement.
- The primary housing contact will coordinate daily meal delivery to the student.
- The primary housing contact will coordinate laundry service for students each Monday and Thursday during isolation/quarantine (mesh laundry bag provided to be set outside door).
- Housing staff will wear fully disposable PPE which initiating the laundry process.
- The Dean of Students will be notified of the student's isolation/quarantine status and will alert professors of approved class absence status. Students are aware that academic resources are provided during isolation/quarantine, and unless prevented due to illness, students should continue to participate in academic programs.
- Students will be provided contact information for a designated academic advisor during the time of isolation/quarantine and will be instructed to alert the advisor of any academic issues.
- UHS will contact students by phone daily to conduct tele-health evaluations. UHS will alert academic advisors regarding any academic issues discovered during the daily evaluations that have not been previously reported by the student to the academic advisor.
- UHS will coordinate with the primary housing contact to procure additional personal care items throughout the duration of isolation/quarantine.
